He was primarily educated at Lucknow University and studied English language and literature, Urdu Humanities and Modern Indian History. Tariq qualified UGC-NET, and wrote his doctoral dissertation on Paul Ricoeur’s Hermeneutics of Suspicion in English and he was awarded the Degree of PhD in English by Lucknow University.

The subject of his doctoral thesis was “Metaphor, Time and Narrative: Paul Ricoeur’s Philosophy of Language and Literary Hermeneutics.” It was a philosophical inquiry about the nature of language and the development of religious hermeneutics to the literary studies. It showed the way how a purely religious discipline legitimately came to be associated with literary hermeneutics. The thesis was broadly oriented towards Paul Ricoeur’s hermeneutics of suspicion.

He teaches English, language, literature, criticism and Contemporary Literary Theories. Till date he has authored a number of books like: *The Prophets of Hope and Survival in the 20th Century Absurdities* (2020), *Diaspora as Cathartic Metaphor: A Hermeneutical Approach* (2020), *New Approaches to English Literature in the Twenty-First Century Millennium* (2021), *Fragrantica Ultimatus: A Handbook for All Competitive Examinations of English Literature* (2021) and *Hermeneutics of Suspicion Framework for Literary Interpretation: Studies in Language, Metaphor, Time and Narrative* (2022), *Victims of Forced Disappearance: Resisting Languages, Literatures and Cultures* (2022).
